# Every Child Ready to Read Skill

## Write

It is beneficial to your child to practice gripping a writing utensil with them. Demonstrate how to hold a writing utensil in a tripod grasp using the thumb, pointer finger, and middle finger. This may take time for them to master and that is normal. You can also show your child how they can trace their ABCs with their finger in alphabet books or on printouts.
