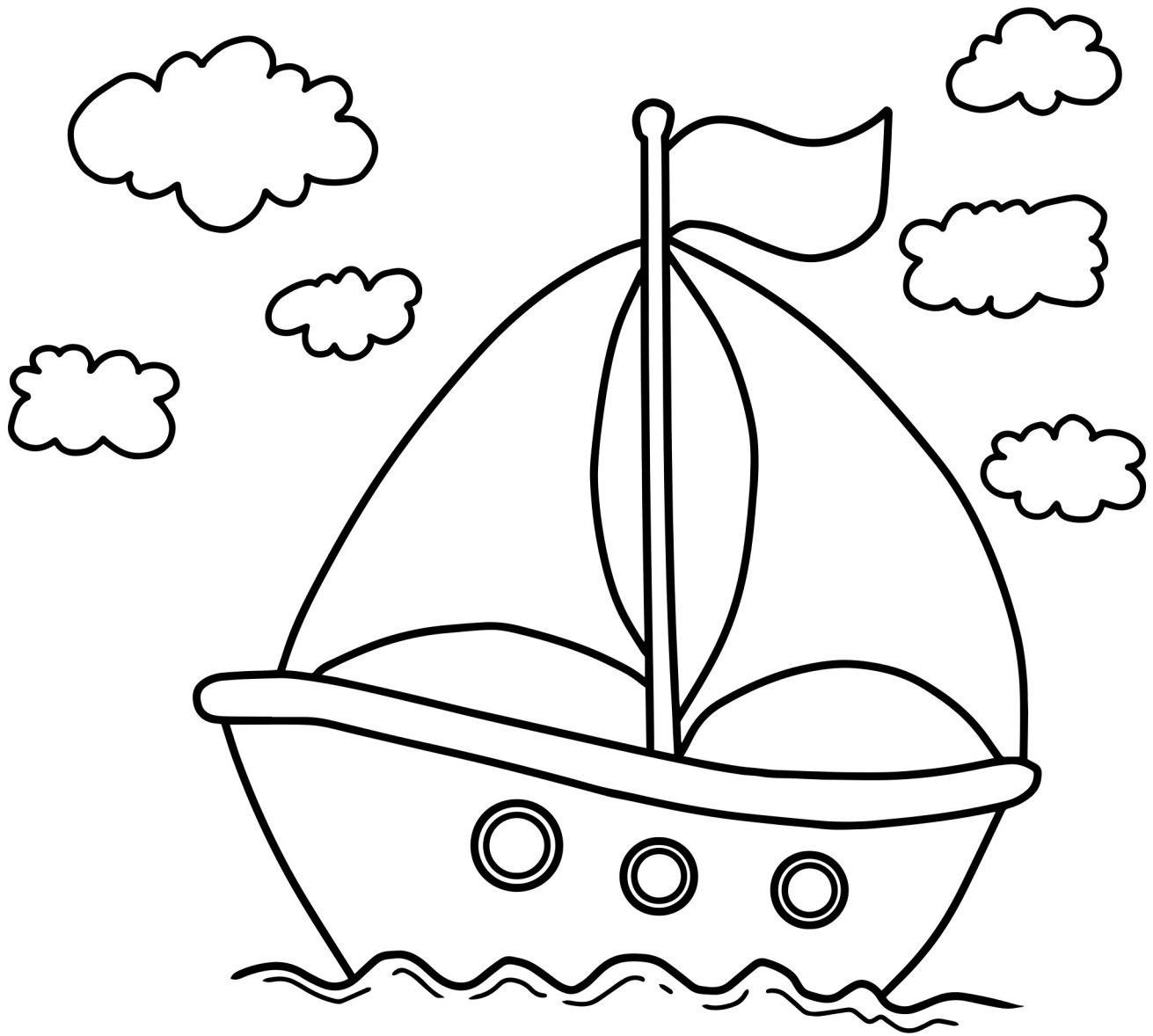


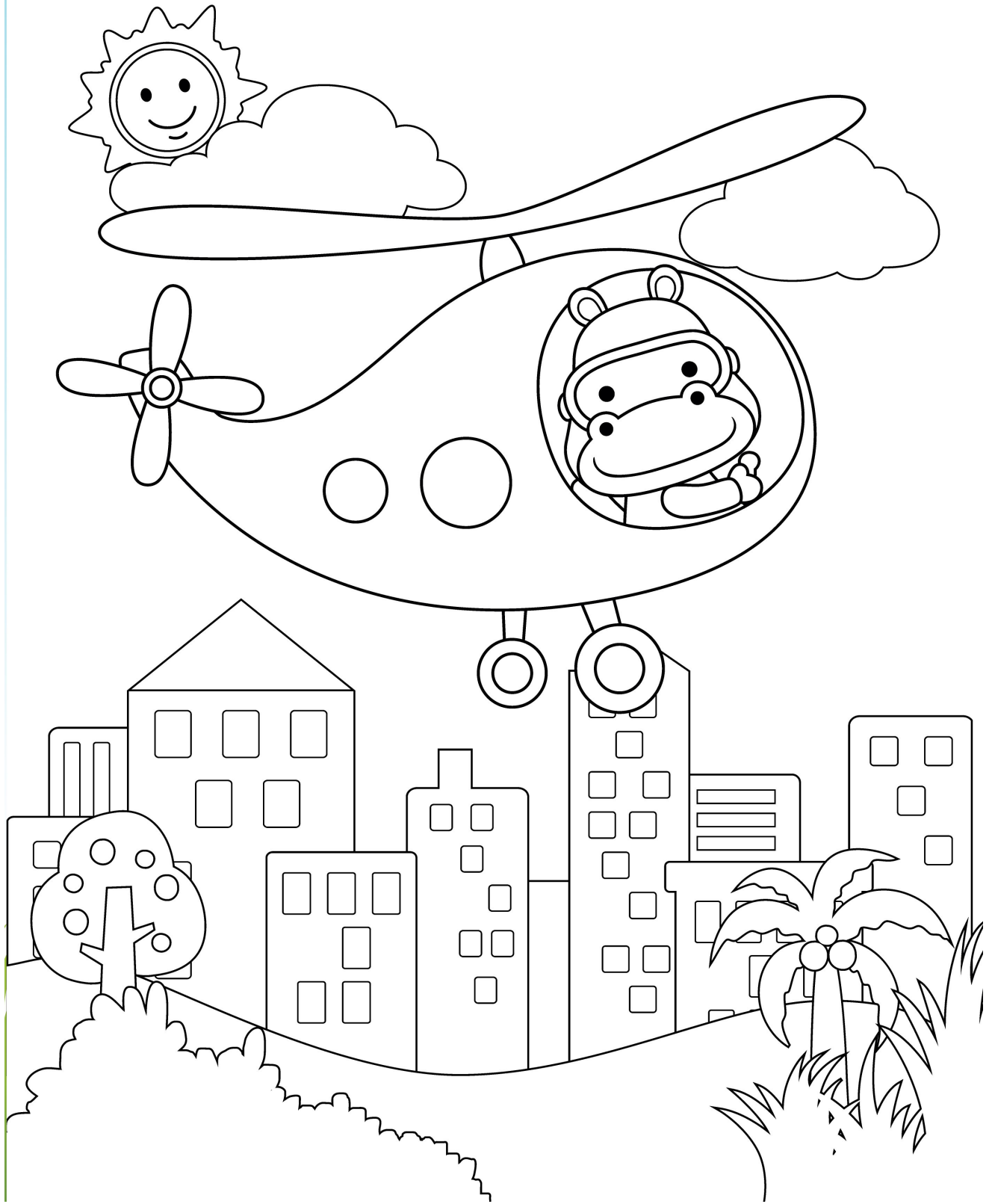

The boats on the sea go up and down all day long.

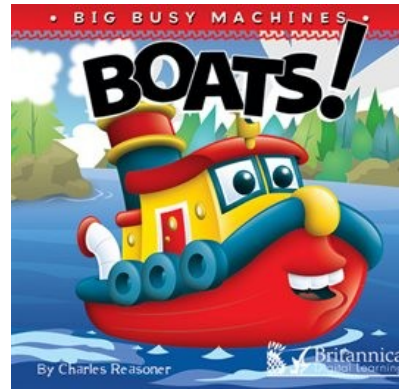
Additional verses:

The boats on the sea sway back and forth...

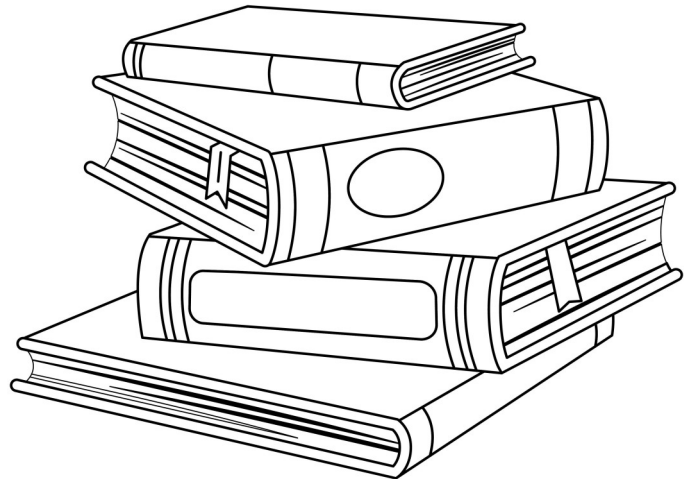
