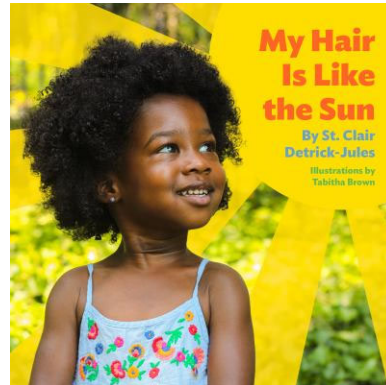

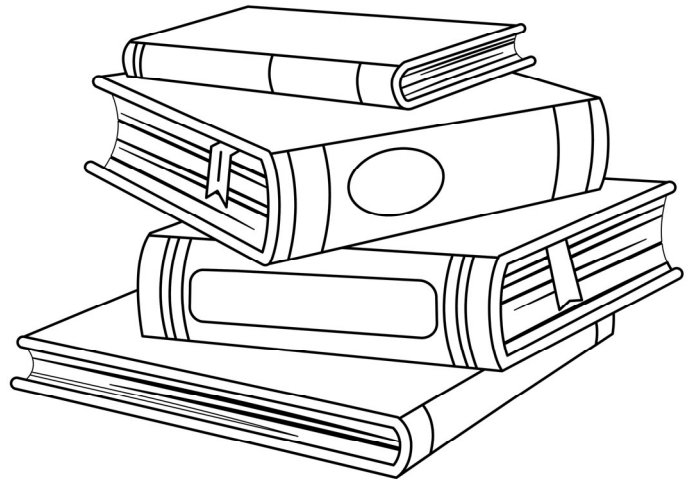

During this first year your baby will begin to respond to you with cooing, gurgling, and babbling. They will respond to “no,” their own name, and simple requests like “come here.” Continue to talk to your child while looking them in their eyes and respond to their noises. Use hand gestures and mimic what your baby does.
